AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 4 December 2015 (Week 23)

The AWEX EMI finished 1ϕ higher (+0.1%) in Australian currency and 10ϕ higher (+1.1%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle this week.

37,172 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 41,730 bales last sale. 7.9% of the offering was passed in.

Although the EMI was only up by 1¢ at the close of selling on Thursday, it had been a good overall week, with a strong finish on Thursday and prices withstanding an increase in the US exchange rate. The EMI moved up in US currency on both Wednesday and Thursday.

There were gains across all average AWEX Merino Micron Price Guides (MPGs), apart from a -0.1% fall at 19.5 and 22 microns. Crossbreds which are in plentiful supply at the moment continued the pattern seen in recent weeks when they eased by around 1.5%, on average.

Merino skirtings finished on a firm note; and it was another good week for oddments. Merino Cardings continued their upward movement. Their average AWEX Indicator has risen by 49ϕ since mid-November.

The US exchange rate finished 0.76ϕ (1.0%) higher to close at 73.15ϕ on Thursday. Financial analysts attributed the rise to a combination of better Australian economic data and a weaker US currency. They also expect no change in the Australian official interest rate in the near future.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe, India and Korea.

Looking ahead, the offering in the current week is expected to be 14.2% less than in the same week last year when 57,300 bales were offered. There was no sale in the following week (Week 25) last year.

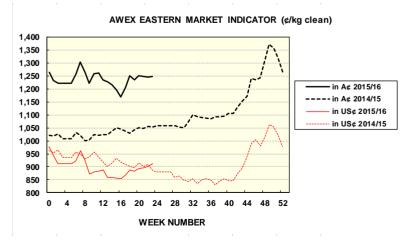

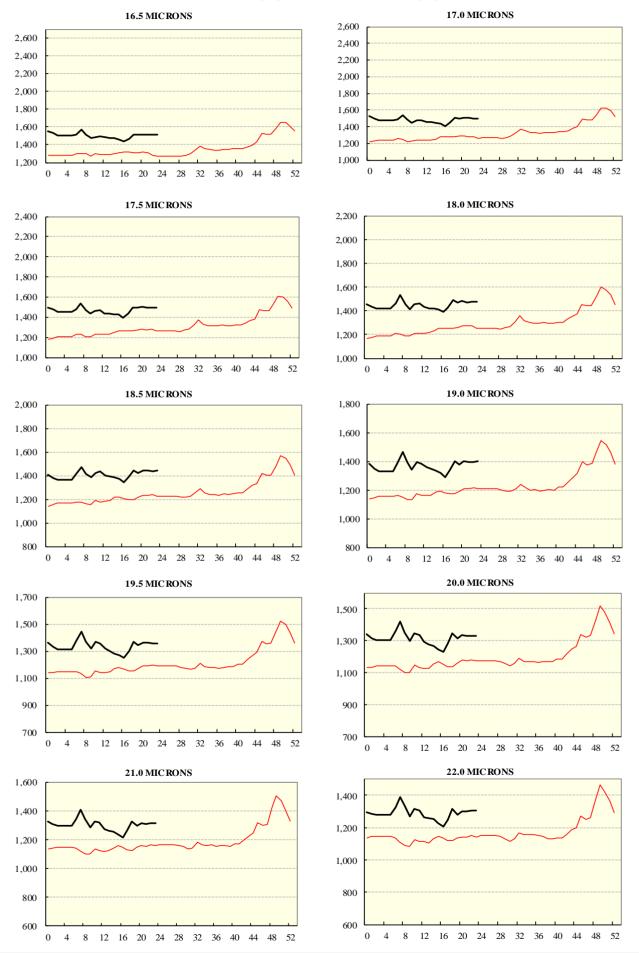
