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AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 12 May 2023 (Week 45)

The AWEX EMI finished at 1284¢, 26¢ lower (-2.0%) in Australian currency and 5¢ lower (-0.6%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle in Week 45.

43,454 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 38,838 bales last sale. 24.8% of the offering was passed in after 5.7% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale. 32,694 bales were sold.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$46.3 million (\$1,416 per bale), taking the season total to \$2.136 billion (\$1,544 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 0.2% greater than in 2021/22.

The market stepped back this week. But it was also noticeable that there was greater grower resistance to the latest falls when the National Pass-In rate reached 29% on Wednesday, and included 29% in Melbourne, 43% in Fremantle and 35% for Merino Fleece. The levels in the South and the West were the highest for the season.

There were falls among all micron ranges that were least at the fine end, but were all over 40¢ from 18.5 microns and up.

The market was not helped when the US Exchange Rate finished 1.00¢ (1.5%) higher to close at 67.64¢ on Wednesday.

As usual, buyers for China were dominant.

Looking ahead, offerings for the coming three sales are expected to range from 39,885 bales to 48,757 bales and to be 4.5% more than in the same period last year. The forecast progressive difference to Week 48 is 0.6%.

In other countries, the South African Cape Wools Indicator was down by 0.3% since last week against a 1.6% appreciation of the Rand against the US Dollar and a 1.9% appreciation against the Euro.

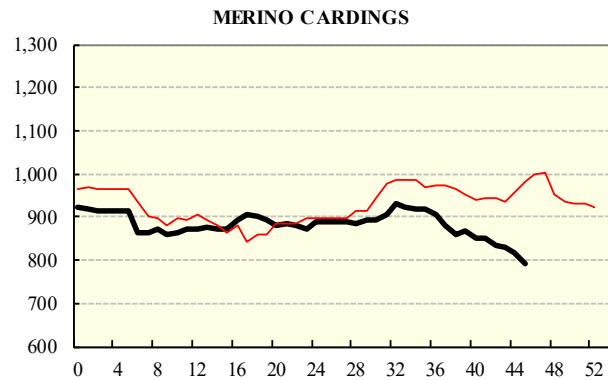
