AUSTRALIAN WOOL INDUSTRIES SECRETARIAT INC. AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 26 May 2023 (Week 47)

The AWEX EMI finished at 1214ϕ , 49ϕ lower (-3.9%) in Australian currency and 39ϕ lower (-4.6%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle in Week 47.

39,039 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 42,489 bales last sale. 27.3% of the offering was passed in after 7.7% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale. 28,375 bales were sold.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$36.9 million (\$1,214 per bale), taking the season total to \$2.223 billion (\$1,310 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 0.4% less than in 2021/22.

It was a disappointing sale, with the EMI down by 49ϕ for the week; with falls over nearly all micron ranges and types. The fall in the EMI over the month of April was 96ϕ . Falls in the average Micron Price Guides were almost entirely between 4% and 5% for Merino wools, while Crossbred wools were less affected.

Growers responded to the changes in the market, by Passing In 27.3% of the offering and withdrawing an additional 7.7%. The Pass In rate of 27.3% was the highest for the season.

The US Exchange Rate fell again, finishing 0.49¢ (-0.7%) lower to close at 65.98¢ on Wednesday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for India

Looking ahead, offerings for the coming three sales are expected to range from 31,906 bales to 47,041 bales and to be 15.5% more than in the same period last year. The large year-to-year difference is mostly due to the current forecast of 47,041 bales for next week (Week 48).




