AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW

Week Ending 3 April 2020 (Week 40)

It was a very difficult week for wool when the AWEX EMI finished at 1287¢, 155¢ lower (-10.7%) in Australian currency and 67¢ lower (-7.8%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle. It was the lowest closing value this season for the EMI in both Australian and US Currencies.

37,713 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 42,934 bales last sale. 44.9% of the offering was passed in after 16.6% of the potential offering was withdrawn prior to sale, leaving 20,782 bales as sold.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$28.3 million (\$1,362 per bale), taking the season total to \$1.647 billion (\$1,685 per bale). The number of bales sold at auction this season is now 18.2% less than in 2018/19.

All sectors of the market were affected. The greatest falls among the Merinos were 10 to 11% from 18 to 22 microns, while the falls across the crossbreds became greater as the diameter increased. The Pass-In Rate for crossbred wool averaged 50% over both days after reaching 59.7% on Wednesday.

The US Exchange Rate finished 1.93¢ (3.3%) higher to close at 61.24¢ on Wednesday. Although poor demand was the main driver in this week's market, the appreciation of Australian currency exacerbated the downward movement of the EMI in Australian currency. The closing US Exchange Rate has ranged from 66.20¢ at the beginning of March to 55.71¢ in mid-March and back to 61.24¢ this week.

Buyers for China were again more dominant than usual, with the Indian and Italian industries experiencing shut downs due to COVID-19.

Looking ahead, the current offering for the coming sale is listed at 44,216 bales. It remains to be seen whether this will eventuate given the poor demand and the consequent high Withdrawn and Pass-In Rates recorded this week.

Sales continue the shut down since mid-March in South Africa and in New Zealand because of COVID-19.

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



