AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW Week Ending 5 May 2017 (Week 44)

The AWEX EMI finished 43¢ higher (+2.9%) in Australian currency and 21¢ higher (+1.9%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle this week. The EMI was only 2¢ less than its peak of 1546¢ two sales ago; and was equal to or greater than 1500¢ for the eighth time in the last nine sales. The season average EMI is now at 1387¢; and likely to exceed 1400¢ by the end of June.

The WMI rose by 45¢ to a new peak value of 1560¢.

38,292 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 52,189 bales last sale. 4.5% of the offering was passed in (including 1.9% of the Merino fleece).

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$62.8 million (\$1,717 per bale), taking the season total to \$2.4 billion.

It was another strong sale with rises across all average AWEX MPGs on both days, except for 18 microns in the West on Thursday. The greatest gains were among the medium Merino micron ranges. This was the area that experienced a correction last week.

Merino skirtings followed the fleece types, while the oddments were in strong demand on both days. Crossbreds were again relatively unchanged.

The US Exchange Rate oscillated during the week, before finishing 0.77¢ (-1.0%) lower to close at 74.08¢ on Thursday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for India and Europe.

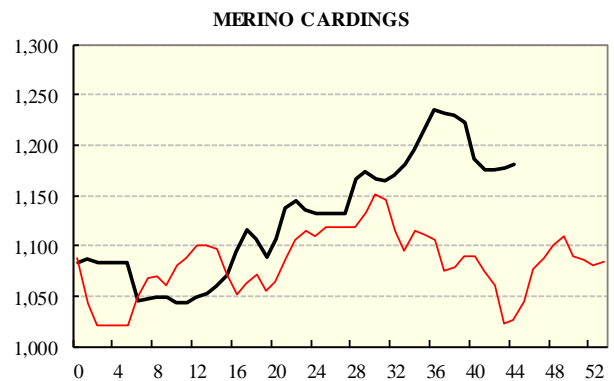

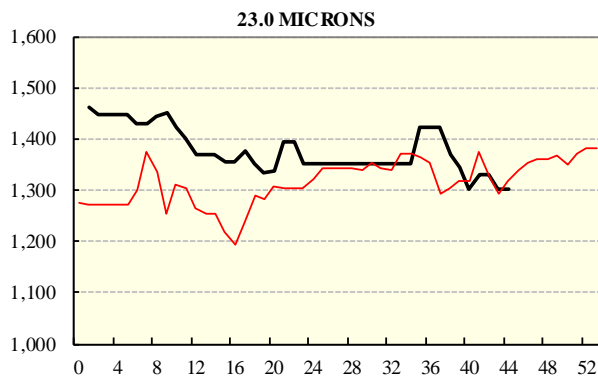
