

# AUSTRALIAN WOOL INDUSTRIES SECRETARIAT INC

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## AWIS WOOL MARKET REVIEW Week Ending 16 March 2018 (Week 37)

The AWEX EMI finished at 1751¢, 27¢ lower (-1.5%) in Australian currency and 13¢ lower (-0.9%) in US currency at sales in Sydney, Melbourne and Fremantle this week.

42,645 bales were on offer nationally, compared with 45,536 bales last sale. 9.0% of the offering (including 10.7% of the Merino fleece) was passed in.

AWEX reports that the value of the wool sold was \$73.3 million (\$1,888 per bale), taking the season total to \$2.4 billion.

The market eased again when sales began on Wednesday, but had a mixed day on Thursday when the AWEX Northern Indicator moved down by a further 19¢, while the Southern Indicator was up by 1¢ and the Western Indicator was down by 3¢.

Both the North and the South started in a downward direction on Thursday. However, there was a recovery as the day progressed in the South that did not occur in the North. Part of the North / South differences appeared to be due to the make-up of the offering. The 16.5 MPG and the 17.0 MPG fell by 32¢ and 20¢ respectively in the North, whereas there were insufficient volumes of these wools in the South for MPG values to be recorded.

While most of the larger falls in the average AWEX MPGs were from 16.5 to 19 microns, the difference between the 16.5 and 22 micron MPGs is still over 1100¢.

The US Exchange Rate finished 0.46¢ (0.6%) higher to close at 78.76¢ on Thursday.

Buyers for China were dominant, with support from buyers for Europe and India.

Looking ahead, the expected offering in the coming sale is 38,800 bales, the smallest offering since early February.

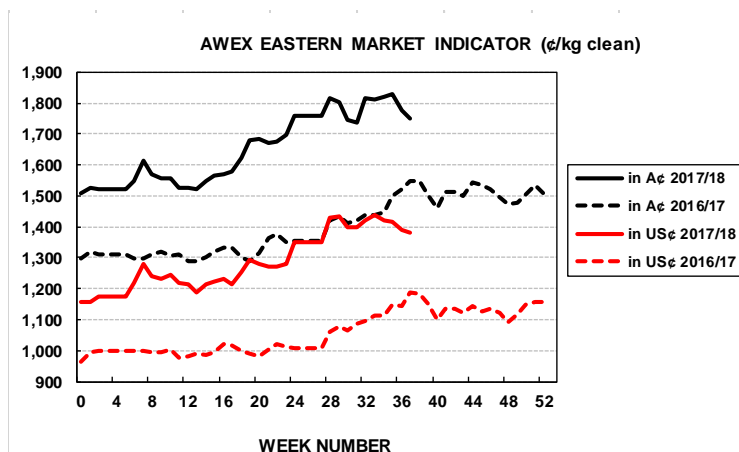

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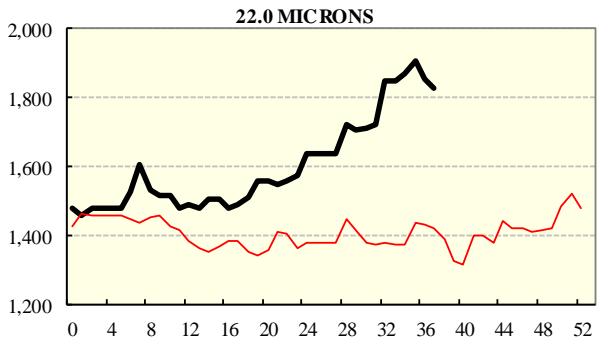

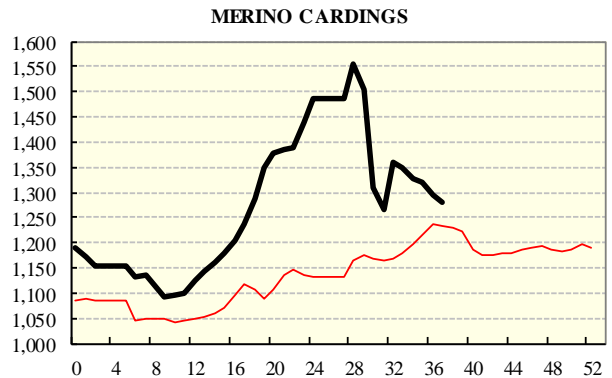

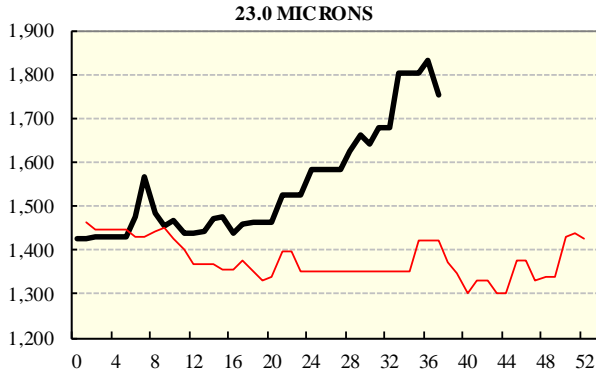
